

In late spring, we joined the National Alliance for Period Supplies (a new program of the National Diaper Bank Network) and started our organization's journey to restore dignity and health to menstruators in our community. In December, our first 150 period supply kits went out the door. Kits include a supplement of pads or tampons, panty liners, flushable cleansing cloths and pain reliever. We're excited to ramp up this new program quickly—be on the lookout for lots more info and updates soon!

The first time families receive diapers from SCDB, they fill out a short, anonymous survey explaining how the diapers have or will impact them. 
Revenue: \$390,660

The majority of the diapers are being stored at the new Nehemiah Manufacturing facility in Lower Price Hill, which has graciously been a cross-docking and storage location for us for just about a year. Above are pictured our friends Eric and Mark from Nehemiah, who help manage our deliveries and inventory and the company's overall support of our organization.



In early April, after a rigorous application and vetting process, we won a 3-year partnership with the Junior League of Cincinnati. This includes a significant grant each year and an incredible committee of over 20 women who are working hard to increase our capacity. In addition to the amazing friendships and community we have already created between our organizations, JLC support in 2018 allowed us to launch our period supply kits and potty-training toolkits, submit exponentially more grants, and keep up with critical administrative office tasks.




Here We Grow Again!
